The Social Ministry Committee has, for many years, provided food baskets at Thanksgiving and Christmas for those in need. Many of those who received them last year were very appreciative. This year due to funding and other constraints, we are having to do things a little differently. We will only be taking names from the congregation for family members or friends who are in need this year, and purchasing grocery store gift cards. We are hoping to put together a small gift basket to go along with the gift card for each person/family whose name has been given to the committee. ***At this time, the plan is to only give one gift card/basket for both the 2022 Thanksgiving and Christmas holidays.***

We still ask for your help by giving a monetary donation for the "Gift Baskets". Place your check or cash in an envelope and mark it for "Social Ministry" and drop it in the offering plate, drop it in the mail, or at the office. Be sure to include your offering envelope number so that we may give you credit. We hope to be able to purchase small items for each gift basket, such as candy, comfort items, etc., with funds left after the gift cards are purchased. Please note that the 2023 offering envelopes will include two envelopes for Social Ministry. It is our hope that we will be able to do something similar again for Easter.

The gift baskets will be assembled and ready for pick-up or delivery by Sunday, November 20th. We will be looking for assistance in assembling the baskets as well as folks who would be willing to deliver to those who have no transportation.
